## Summer Reading Assignment for 4th Grade

Dear Parents.

In this packet you will find reading ideas that to present the book <u>The BFG</u> by Roald Dahl this summer. The **BFG** is to be read and choose one of three project ideas. This project is to be done over the summer, handed in at the beginning of school, and it will be a grade towards the first marking period. I have given three projects that you can choose from, but your child only need to pick one.

## The ideas are as follows:

- 1. Read the book. Choose your favorite character from the book. Create a trading card about your character. Print out your trading card and display it on small poster board or cardboard.

Or use a separate sheet of paper to create your comic strip or cartoon.
- 3. Read the book, **The BFG**, and think of words that best describe the book. Print the puzzle or get graph paper and create your own word search puzzle.
- 4. On a separate piece of paper write a letter to your friend and explain why you found this book, **The BFG**, to be funny. Use examples from text to support your opinion. There should be a beginning, then three reasons with examples why the story is funny, then a conclusion. The letter should be at least a page long.
